## Finding physical resources in Nielsen Library

### LC Subject Heading Call numbers (Main stacks and Oversize)

- G = Maps
- GA = Mathematical Geography/ Cartography
- GB = Physical Geography
- GC = Oceanography
- GE = Environmental Sciences
- GF = Human Ecology / Anthropogeography

### FIRST FLOOR

- New books, Interlibrary Loan, Circulation Desk, Reserves, Computer Lab, Restrooms located in NE corner.

### SECOND FLOOR

- Reference Desk, Computer Lab, Periodicals (i.e., journals) – current and bound, Newspapers, Print Indexes, Microfilm/form/fiche, Government Documents, Maps, Study rooms, Ethernet connections (2), Restrooms located as follows: women's in NW corner, men's in NE corner.

### THIRD FLOOR

- Main stacks, Oversize, Videos, Children's collection, Study areas, Special Collections, Restrooms located as follows: women's in NW corner, men's in NE corner.

### Government Documents

Hot tip: Mary recommends looking for online documents. Print and microform documents are a hit and miss proposition (at best) at Nielsen Library. Factoid: having a record in the Marmot Catalog does not mean we own the item!
